Heard the parties.

The appellants are apprehending their arrest in connection with Motihari (SC/ST) P.S.Case No.116 of 2018 , registered for offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 354(A), 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3(i)(a)(g)(r)(s) (x) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

Allegation against the appellants is that as the husband of the informant deposed against them as such they were threatening and abusing by caste name and also assaulted her husband and when she went to save him, she was also assaulted and they tried to disrob her. It is also alleged that they have also surrounded her land.

Submission of the learned counsel for the appellants is that Anil Kumar has lodged a Title Suit against the informant and others due to that the present case has been lodged. There is no specific allegation and the injuries are also simple in nature.



Heard learned Spl.P.P. , who has opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that as the husband of the informant has deposed that they have abused and assaulted. .

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the appellants, however, the appellants are directed to surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from the date of order and make prayer for regular bail, which will be considered by the learned court below on its own merit without being prejudiced by the order of this Court.

With the aforesaid observation, this appeal is dismissed.
