ORAL ORDER

The accusation is that while informant Suga Devi used to reside at her matrimonial house situated in village-Jainagar along with her minor daughter Sunita Kumari and her husband used to reside at village-Karmawa. On 08.06.2018, petitioner and Narad Prasad came at the house of the informant and told that her husband is ill and he is admitted in Raxaul



hospital. Thereafter, informant along with her daughter proceeded with the petitioner and Narad Prasad for Raxaul. When she reached at Raxaul, then petitioner and Narad Prasad kidnapped her minor daughter Sunita, while she searched about her daughter, but no trace was found.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the minor daughter of the informant used to reside at her maternal uncle's house in village-Bhagwanpur Pipra, P.S. Rajpur, District-Rohtahat, Nepal, but with ulterior motive and grudge, the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his prayer for grant of anticipatory bail stands rejected. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within four weeks and pray for regular bail, which would be considered by the trial Court in accordance with law without being prejudiced by the order of this Court.
