No. 7829 of 1993 for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to the respondents commanding them to pay the salary to the petitioner left due from 01.12.1988 to 31.3.1989 and D.A. arrears from 1983 and again from 18.12.1989 alongwith arrears D.A. and other emoluments upto date for which the petitioners were deprived of by the illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional actions of Respondents and also for inclusion of his name in Annexure 12 to the writ
