The appointment of the petitioner on the post of *Anganbari Sevika* in Ward No. 07 under Village-Jugliraykura, Katoriya in the district of Banka was set aside by the District Programme Officer, Banka by order dated 11.01.2019 on the complaint made by private respondent No. 7/Taranum Khatun.

2. The petitioner, without approaching the District Magistrate, Banka in appeal, has preferred the present writ



petition.

3. Under the aforesaid circumstance, the petitioner is directed to make an appeal before the District Magistrate, Banka (respondent No. 4) within a period of four weeks from today.

4. Should such a memo of appeal be filed within the aforesaid period, the District Magistrate, Banka shall pass a reasoned order in accordance with law within a further period of six weeks thereafter.

5. With the aforesaid observation/direction, the writ petition stands disposed off.
