The petitioner has been in custody since 10.01.2019 in connection with Sasaram (Mufasil) P.S. Case No. 173/2018 registered for the offense punishable under Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner who is the father-in-law of the deceased girl. It is further submitted that the mother-in-law has since been extended the privilege of anticipatory bail in Cr. Misc. No. 22824 of 2019 vide order dated 11.04.2019.
