Petitioner seeks bail in **Sessions Trial No.356 of 2018**
arising out of Pawna P.S. Case No.39 of 2018 instituted for the
offence under Section(s) 302, 376(d)/34 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is
not named in the First Information Report. He has been arrested
merely on suspicion by the police. Thereafter, police recorded
his confessional statement. He has no criminal antecedents.

In the written report, it is alleged that sister-in-law of
the informant, namely, Kajal Devi had gone outside after taking
meal at 10.00 AM for picking garbage. At 7.00 PM, in the
evening she returned. At that time, three persons of village
Maniyach speaking like *Mushahar* caste whom she could not



identify took her sister-in-law towards field. She did not come in the night. On the next day at 8.00 AM, she got information from co-villager that one lady is lying half-dead on the border of Khopira-Maniyach. The informant went and saw her sister-in-law from whose mouth and nose blood was coming. She was brought to hospital. She died in course of treatment.

In this manner, there is no allegation of any specific overt act against the petitioner in the written report.

Petitioner is in custody since 16.07.2018 having clean antecedents.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Additional District & Sessions Judge, VI, Bhojpur, Ara**, in connection with **Sessions Trial No.356 of 2018 arising out of Pawna P.S. Case No.39 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
