APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under  
Sections 365, 366 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that the accused persons  
kidnapped the daughter of the informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the  
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation  
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The  
petitioner is in custody since 21-04-2018. Charge sheet has  
already been submitted. The victim eloped with the petitioner  
out of love affairs. Later on, when she came in clutches of her  
parents, then under inducement of her parents, she made  
statement u/S 164 Cr.P.C. No sexual abuse is alleged against the



petitioner.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is  
named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let  
the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing  
bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of  
the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub  
Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Biraul at Darbhanga in  
connection with Ghanshyampur P.S. Case No. 47 of 2018.
