ORAL ORDER

2 22-04-2019 The present writ application has been filed by the petitioner for a direction to respondents to protect his right, title and interest over the land.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the proceeding under section 144 Cr.P.C. was initiated and it was found that the land belongs to the petitioner and now the respondents purposes to settle the land which may adversely affect the egress and ingress of the petitioner.

Considering the apprehension of the petitioner, the writ application is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Sub Divisional Officer, Barh, Patna who shall examine the grievance of the petitioner objectively and pass appropriate order and if it is found that right of the petitioner is



adversely affected by any act of the respondents or if the respondents purposes to make any allotment, the petitioner should be heard and by giving reasoning the respondents may pass appropriate order.

With the aforesaid, the present writ application stands disposed of.
