4 17-07-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in
connection with Ghosi P.S. Case No.326 of 2018, disclosing
offences under Sections 302, 201, 34 of IPC.

Allegation against the petitioner is of causing death of
his daughter-in-law.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is
that no specific allegation has been attributed against him and he
has falsely been implicated in this case.

Heard learned A.P.P. as well as learned counsel
appearing on behalf of the opposite party no.2, they have
opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail and drawing my
attention towards the statement of the daughter of deceased
during course of investigation, which disclosed that petitioner
along with other accused persons assaulted the deceased,
causing her death.



Having heard both sides, in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, however, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned court below and make prayer for regular bail.

With the aforesaid, this application is dismissed.
