5 10-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered under Sections 498A, 354A/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

There is demand of dowry and committing torturing
by the petitioner on the opposite party no.2, who happens to be
his wife.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the allegation against the petitioner is false as the instant case
has been lodged by opposite party no.2 after filing Matrimonial
(Divorce) case no. 567 of 2017 under section 24 (1)(i) of the
Special Marriage Act, 1954 by him. It is also submitted that the
opposite party no.2 was earlier married with one Kunal Yadav.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let



the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below it within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patna in Mahila Police Station Case No. 169 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
