2 08-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 457, 380 of the Indian Penal Code. Later on, Section
411 of I.P.C. has also been added.

Allegation is that unknown thieves committed theft
amounting to about Rs.4 lacs.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody 25.10.2018. Charge sheet has been
submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is not
named in the F.I.R. His name has come on confessional
statement of co-accused. No incriminating article has been
recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has



not been put on T.I.P.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. III, Patna in connection with Rajivnagar P.S. case No.157 of 2018.
