for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest for the offences alleged under Sections 401/414/34 IPC registered in connection with Sonapur (Hajipur) Rail P.S. Case No. 01/2019.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated merely on the extra judicial confessional statement of co-accused Pappu Kumar, except which there is no objective material to connect the petitioner with the alleged occurrence. Recovery of knife and a mobile phone has been made from the said co-accused Pappu Kumar and no recovery of any incriminating articles has been made from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner claims clean antecedents.

4. Be that as it may, in the event of the petitioner's arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Railways, Sonapur, Saran, in connection with Sonapur (Hajipur) Rail P.S. Case No. 01/2019 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and also subject to the following further



conditions:

- i. That one of the bailors shall be a close relative of the petitioner.
- ii. That the petitioner shall not indulge in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.
- iii. That the petitioner shall co-operate with the investigation, if not already concluded, and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the State shall be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.
- iv. The petitioner shall remain physically present in Court on each and every date during trial and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.
