ORAL ORDER

2 18-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 21.02.2019 in connection with Nokha P.S. Case No.27 of 2018 registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioner and that after his arrest in connection with the present case, he was remanded in three other cases of similar nature. It is further submitted that the alleged recoveries were from near Kali Mandir and not from the conscious possession of the petitioner.



Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd Additional District & Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge (Excise), Rohtas at Sasaram, in connection with Nokha P.S. Case No.27 of 2018.
