learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 30(ka) and 56(kha) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

60 litres of country made liquor is said to have
been recovered from the rear side of the house of the petitioner
and the petitioner was apprehended.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that no incriminating article has been recovered from
the conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has no
concern either with the seized liquor or place of recovery. Place
of recovery is open place and is accessible to anyone. There is



violation of Section 100 Cr.P.C. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent and has been languishing in custody since 02.03.2019.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise, Gaya in connection with Excise Case No. 105 of 2019.
