3 22-02-2019 The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Dhanha P.S.Case No. 159 of 2018 registered under Sections 147,148,149,224,307,323,332,353,447 and 504 of the Indian penal Code.

Allegation as per FIR is that police personnel when went to arrest the son of the petitioner no. 1, petitioners along with several other accused persons got furious from the police and attacked on them.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is that they are ladies and injuries are also found simple in nature on the police personnel.

Case No. 159 of 2018; subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
