petitioner and one co-accused Bittu Kumar Singh were

traveling. Submission is that the petitioner does not have any

criminal antecedent and as a matter of fact, he was caught by the

officials on mere suspicion.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as

well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner, above



named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II cum Special Judge (Exercise), Kishanganj in connection with Special Case No. 85 of 2019 arising out of P. R. No. 58 of 2018-19.
