2      10-04-2019                      Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and counsel  
appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with  
Benipatti P.S. Case No. 18 of 2019 for the offence under Section  
30 (a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. He further submits that in  
the instant case total 987 liters liquor was seized. Learned  
counsel for the petitioner next contended that the alleged  
recovered was made from the hutment of co-accused Babloo  
Sonar and no recovery has been made either from the conscious  
possession of the petitioner or from his house. He submits that  
petitioner is in custody since 30.01.2019.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has no criminal



antecedent and the alleged recovered was made from the hutment of co-accused Babloo Sonar not from the petitioner, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Let, the petitioner named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned IInd Addl. Sessions Judge-cum- Special Judge, Excise, Madhubani in connection with Benipatti P.S. Case No. 18 of 2019.
