2 19-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Mahila P.S. Case No. 47 of 2013 registered under Sections
376, 341, 323, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely
been implicated in this case. The F.I.R. is lodged after lapse of 8
years of the alleged occurrence. Further submission is that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of
the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in



the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M., Begusarai in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 47 of 2013, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
