The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in Complaint Case No.40 of 2013 (Registered No.3603/14) registered for the offence under Section 498(A) of the Indian Penal Code.

Acquisition is of torturing the complainant O.P.No.2 by her husband and in-laws due to non-fulfillment of demand of motorcycle and removing her from her matrimonial house snatching her belongings.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are the father-in-law and mother-in-law of the



complainant O.P.No.2 and they have falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, provisional bail granted to the petitioners, above named, vide order dated 10.04.2019 is hereby confirmed.
