The claim of pre-emption under Section 16(3) of the Bihar Land Reforms (Fixation of Ceiling Area and Acquisition of Surplus Land) Act, 1961 (for short 'the Act'), raised by/on behalf of the original petitioner has been rejected by all courts.

Since Section 16(3) of the Act has been repealed with



the enactment of the Bihar Land Reforms (Fixation of Ceiling Area and Acquisition of Surplus Land) (Amendment) Act, 2019, this writ application has become infructuous. It is according dismissed as infructuous.
