2 18-04-2019 The learned counsel for the parties are in agreement that the present case is squarely covered by a judgment rendered by the learned Division Bench ***dated 18.04.2018*** passed in ***L.P.A. no. 1472 of 2015 (The State of Bihar & Ors. v. Rhituraj Saurabh & Anr.)***.

Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent no. 6 by filing an appropriate representation within a period of four weeks from today and in case, such representation is filed, the



same shall be disposed of by the respondent no. 6 within a period of eight weeks thereafter and in case, the case of the petitioner is found similar to the respondents of the aforesaid judgment ***dated 18.04.2018***, similar relief would be granted to the petitioner herein within a period of four weeks therefrom.
