2 16-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since 09.03.2019 in a case for the offence registered under Sections 290, 272, 273 of the IPC, 30(a) and 37(b) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that total 40 liters toddy is said to have been recovered.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. It is alleged that total 40 liters toddy is recovered from joint house of the petitioner. The name of the



petitioner has come in the present case on the basis of alleged recovery made from joint house of the petitioner where other family members also reside. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr. P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R/ Complaint Case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.D.J.-II-cum-Special Judge, Nawada, in connection with Nawada (Town) P.S. Case No. 266 of 2019.
