The petitioner is in custody in connection with Tekari
P.S. Case No. 117 of 2018 for the offenses under Sections 341,
504, 506, 324, 379, 511/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section
25(1)(b) (a), 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. With reference to
Annexure-2, he submits that the petitioner himself is victim of
acid attack and the informant of this case was accused in Tekari
P.S. Case No. 125/2018.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has no
criminal antecedent and the fact that the informant was made
accused at the instance of the petitioner for acid attack, the



Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Tekari P.S. Case No. 117 of 2018.
