2 23-04-2019 The learned counsel for the parties including the learned counsel appearing for the University submit that the present case is squarely covered by a judgment reported in *2018 (3) PLJR (Akhilanand Singh & Ors. vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.)*, hence the present writ petition can be disposed of with a direction to the Respondent no.6 to absorb the services of the petitioner in terms of the judgment passed by this Court in the case of Akhilanand Singh & ors.(supra) as well as for payment of the consequential benefits in terms thereof.
