3 15-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the opposite party no.2.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 106 of 2018, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 498(A), 341, 342, 323, 326, 328/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of D.P. Act.

In pursuance of the order dated 26.04.2019, the petitioner and the opposite party no.2 are physically present before this Court. The opposite party no.2 has stated that it is not possible for her to stay with the petitioner and refused to go



along with him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 26.04.2019, he has already deposited Rs.2000/- in the account of opposite party no.2. In support thereof, he has shown a bank receipt dated 14.05.2019.

In such view of the matter, let the petitioner, above-named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dehri, Rohtas, in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 106 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
