learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is accused in connection with
Sahebganj P.S. Case No. 375 of 2018 registered under Section
304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of killing of the daughter of the
informant by her husband and in-laws due to non-fulfillment of
demand of dowry.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is the father-in-law of the deceased and no specific
overt act with regard to torture and demand of dory has been
made against the petitioner. It is further submitted that petitioner
is in custody since 08.01.2019 and co-accused, Saraswati Devi

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioner above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M.-I, West, Muzaffarpur, in connection with Sahebganj P.S. Case No. 375 of 2018. Out of two sureties, one surety must be the close relative of the petitioner.
