2 18-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Janta Bazar P.S. Case No. 07 of 2018 for the offence
punishable under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal
Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, is
innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, the
petitioner happens to be owner of the alleged motorcycle
and nothing has been recovered from the conscious
possession of the petitioner, which is evident from seizure



list. Hence, the petitioner may be granted the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioner in the event of surrender within a period of four weeks be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 6th Additional District Judge, Saran at Chapra in connection with Janta Bazar P.S. Case No. 07 of 2018 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
