2 19-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Maner P.S. Case No. 84 of 2019 corresponding to Special
Case No. 1690 of 2019 registered under Section 30(a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. He has
falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty village politics.
Further submission is that on perusal of Seizure List, it appears
that the alleged recovery has been made from the bank of river
Ganga. Nothing has been recovered by the possession of this
petitioner.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Special Judge, Excise, Patna in connection with Maner P.S. Case No. 84 of 2019 corresponding to Spl. Case No. 1690 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
