The petitioner seeks a direction to the respondent authorities for making payment to him the salary for the period May, 2018 to 31.01.2019 which has been withheld without any reason whatsoever.

2. The petitioner has served as a *Chaukidar* and has superannuated.

3. Unfortunately, the necessary factual inputs have not been provided in the writ petition.



4. However, the petitioner is directed to make a representation before the Circle Officer, Teghra, Begusarai (respondent No. 6) within a period of four weeks from today, who, after verifying the records, shall pass a reasoned order within a further period of four weeks thereafter.

5. If the claim of the petitioner is found to be tenable, necessary order shall be passed/caused to be passed, releasing the salary of the petitioner for the period as claimed.

6. With the aforesaid observation/direction, the writ petition stands disposed off.
