The short submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner is that in light of the Full Bench judgment of this Court in the case of Mobina Khatoon -Versus- State of Bihar & Others, reported in 2019 (1) PLJR 1015, the State Government has come out with Resolution dated 03.07.2019.
