appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Barauni Rail P.S. Case No. 177 of 2018 for the offence under
Sections 379,411/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Allegation against this
petitioner is that he was involved in theft in train. Learned
counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing was recovered
from the possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the
petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since
29.1.2019.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has no criminal



antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
