2 19-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners have been in custody since 24.12.2018
in connection with Rajoun P.S. Case No. 506/2018 registered for
the offence punishable under Sections 30(a), 32(2) of Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners are the drivers of the two vehicles which were
alleged to be carrying liquor, were apprehended and were taken
into custody though it was not to their knowledge that the items
which have been loaded on the vehicle were containing such
items of liquor as the bags in question were completely sealed.



It is further submitted that the said recovery have not been made from the conscious possession of the petitioners, the petitioners may be extended the privilege of regular bail and they are not having any criminal antecedent.

In view of the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioners above named be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge, IInd, Banka, in connection with Rajoun P.S. Case No. 506/2018.
