2 23-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Kajra
P.S. Case No. 03 of 2019, registered for the offence punishable
under Section 386 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Allegation against this
petitioner is that he was involved in putting pressure to pay levy
on informant. Learned counsel for the petitioner next contended
that petitioner was not named in the FIR and his name surfaced
in the instant case on the confessional statement of one Bablu
Kumar. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is in custody since 23.1.2019.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has no criminal



antecedent the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Let the petitioner named above be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Lakhisarai in connection with Kajra P.S. Case No. 03 of 2019.
