3 22-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the informant and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 498(A) of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the informant has stated before this Court that there is settlement between the parties out side the court and he is not opposing the anticipatory bail petition. Petitioner no. 1 is the father-in-law and petitioner no. 2 is the mother-in-law of the victim.



In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-II, Kaimur at Bhabua in connection with Complaint Case No. 274 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
