2 03-07-2019 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel appearing for the State.

Considering the criminal antecedent the prayer for bail of the petitioner was refused on 06.12.2018 vide order passed in Cr. Misc. No. 71421 of 2018.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that two country made pistols and 15 live cartridges were recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 17.06.2018. However, co-accused, Brajesh Kumar @ Brajesh Kumar Singh and Kanhai Thakur @ Kanhai Kumar Thakur, have already been allowed privilege of bail vide Cr. Misc. No. 44714 of 2018 and 53252 of 2018 on 01.08.2018 and 10.09.2018 respectively. The petitioner is in custody since about one year.



Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Muzaffarpur Sadar P.S. Case No. 417 of 2018 to the satisfaction of Sri Aftab Alam, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Muzaffarpur, or the successor Court, subject to the condition that one of the bailors would be parent or a close relative of the petitioner.
