ORAL ORDER

2 02-07-2019 Claim of the petitioners for arrears of salary for the period November, 2005 to February, 2006 has been raised in the instant proceedings.

Relying upon the averments made in the counter affidavit, learned State Counsel submits that on 03.03.2015, the Block Development Officer, Hasanpura has communicated to the District Panchayat Raj Officer, Siwan, that bills for payment of arrears for the said period, has already been sent to the Treasury Officer, Siwan. In view of the said development, during pendency of the instant proceeding, he submits that the



relief, claimed in the writ petition, has become infructuous.

Since, none appears on behalf of the petitioners, without going into the merits of the said submission, writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
