2 24-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Uchakagaon. P.S. Case No. 293 of 2018 for the offence punishable under Sections 363, 366A and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, who are of clean antecedent, are innocent and have not committed any offence. In fact, there was love affair between the victim and co-accused Brij



Kishore Mahato and the victim voluntarily fled away from her house and performed marriage with Brij Kishore Mahato, this fact is evident from the statement of victim, who is major, recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., which is at Annexures-2 and 3. These petitioners are close relatives of Brij Kishore Mahato and they have no concern with the alleged occurrence. Hence, the petitioners may be granted the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioners in the event of surrender within a period of four weeks be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-IX, Gopalganj in connection with Uchakagaon P.S. Case No. 293 of 2018 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
