ORAL ORDER

2 03-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application for anticipatory bail, arises out of Khodawandpur Police Station Case No. 61 of 2016 disclosing offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 448, 308, 379, 427 and 325 of the Indian Penal Code.

There is general and omnibus allegation against the persons named in the First Information Report of having assaulted the informant and his son, when he wanted to intercept. There is also allegation of taking away certain articles and cash of general and omnibus.



In the facts and circumstances, as noted above, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioners, above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) each, with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Manjhaul, Begusarai in connection with Khodawandpur Police Station Case No. 61 of 2016, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioners shall present themselves before the Police/Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on their part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, their bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
