On 27.08.2019 when the matter was last listed, it was

In the circumstance and since no adjudication is required, writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent no.6 to take final decision on the petitioner's representation dated 18.03.2014 (Annexure 5) within the period of three months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order. If dues are found admissible, same should also be paid to the petitioner within the aforesaid period.
