Nobody appears on behalf of the petitioner. Learned
A.P.P. for the State is present.

2. On 10.08.2018, the Court had granted one week
further time to the petitioner to file affidavit in terms of jointness
of opposite party no. 2 with the brother, failing which the
application was to stand dismissed against the concerned opposite
party without further reference to the Bench. The same not being
complied with, the application has stood dismissed against the
opposite party no. 2 on 17.08.2018.

3. As the case relates to allegation of demand of dowry
against the petitioner by the opposite party no. 2, who is the wife
of the petitioner and the Court directing for making the wife as



opposite party no. 2 and now the case having dismissed against her, the application cannot be considered on merits in the absence of the opposite party no. 2.

4. In the aforesaid background, the application stands dismissed.
