Petitioner apprehends his arrest in Sheikhpura P.S.
Case No.644 of 2018, registered under Section 323 and other
minor Sections of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant alleged that after receiving secret
inputs that illegal mining of sand was going on, the informant
went to verify and saw a tractor laden with sand. The driver of
the tractor fled away after seeing the police but more than 100
villagers assembled there, made protest and also took away the
tractor from the custody of the police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
villagers made protest against the illegal activities of the police.
The villagers did not use any force. No specific allegation is
made against the petitioner.



Taking into consideration the facts and nature of allegations made against the petitioner, let petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Sheikhpura in connection with Sheikhpura P.S. Case No.644 of 2018, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
