APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the offences under Sections 356, 379 and 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution case, in short, is that that while the informant was on patrolling duty, on confidential informant, he recovered one mobile phone which is suspected to be stolen property.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 25.1.2019. Charge-sheet/prosecution report has been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the



present case. One mobile phone is alleged to have been recovered in this case. The petitioner had no knowledge that the mobile phone in question is stolen property. He has been made accused due to mistake of fact.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. -II, Danapur, Patna in connection with Rupaspur P.S. Case No. 44 of 2019.
