Petitioner seeks bail in **Jagdishpur (Goradih) P.S.**
Case No.445 of 2018 instituted for the offence under Section(s)
392, 411 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is
not named in the First Information Report. No Test
Identification Parade has been held. No incriminating article has
been recovered from his possession.

During investigation, one motorcycle is said to have
been recovered from the house of this petitioner. The police has
alleged that same motorcycle was used in the commission of
offence.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that Petitioner is in



custody since 10.10.2018 having clean antecedents.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, VII, Bhagalpur**, in connection with **Jagdishpur (Goradih) P.S. Case No.445 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
