2 19-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 18.03.2019 in connection with G.O. Case No.272 of 2019 arising out of Ashok Paper Mill P.S. Case No.27 of 2019 registered for the offences under Sections 30(a) and 41(i) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioners but from the backyard of the kitchen of the petitioners, which cannot be saddled on the shoulders of the petitioners.



Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and that the petitioner has not criminal antecedent, let both the above named petitioners be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-V-cum-Special Judge (Excise Act, 2016, in connection with G.O. Case No.272 of 2019 arising out of Ashok Paper Mill P.S. Case No.27 of 2019.
