The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner would be satisfied in case he is granted liberty to
file representation before the respondent no.3 and the
respondent no.3 may be directed to dispose of the representation
of the petitioner within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner shall
file a representation before the respondent no.3 regarding his
grievances raised in the writ petition within a period of four



weeks from today and the respondent no.3 is directed to dispose of the same within a period of twelve weeks thereafter, considering the judgment passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court dated 27.7.2017 passed in LPA No. 269 of 2016 (Dr. Brahm Deo Sah Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.).

The present writ petition is disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
