3 22-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30 (A) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner or the house. Recovery made from open filed of the village. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on



anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 3rd Additional District and Sessions Judge, Nalanda at Biharsharif in connection with Islampur P.S. Case No. 51 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
