2 25-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Dulhinbazar P.S. Case No. 294 of 2017 for the offence
punishable under Sections 302, 201 and 120B of the Indian
Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner, who are of clean antecedent, is
innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, the
petitioner has been made accused in this case merely on the
confessional statement of the co-accused, Shiv Shankar
Singh. Except confession of the co-accused, there is nothing
on record against the petitioner. Hence, the petitioner may



be granted the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioner in the event of surrender within a period of four weeks be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-III, Danapur, Patna in connection with Dulhinbazar P.S. Case No. 294 of 2017 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
