Petitioner seeks bail in **Narpatganj P.S. Case No.180
of 2019** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 30(a), 37(c)
of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is alleged that 30 litres foreign liquor has been
recovered from house of the petitioner. The petitioner was also
found in drunken condition.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that Petitioner is in
custody since 22.03.2019 having clean antecedents.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of
the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of
Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount



each to the satisfaction of the **2nd Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Judge, Araria**, in connection with **Narpatganj P.S. Case No.180 of 2019**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
