counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Supaul
P.S. Case No. 73 of 2019 for the offences under Sections 25(1-
b)a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
05.02.2019. He further submits that in the instant case on search
one loaded pistol with live cartridges were recovered from the
possession of the petitioner.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal
antecedent and he has remained in custody for more than three
months, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let
the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing



bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Supaul in connection with Supaul P.S. Case No. 73 of 2019.
