3 06-05-2019 It is submitted by Mr. Amresh Kumar Sinha, appearing for the petitioner, that the petitioner is working as Assistant Director in the Mines Department, though the emoluments and benefits for the post have not been extended to him. He submits that by virtue of harmonious construction of Rules 103 and 58 of the Bihar Service Code he would be raising his claim for being granted pay and benefits of the post attached to Assistant Director, Mines, before respondent No. 4.

In view of such submission, nothing survives in the



instant writ proceeding.

The petitioner would be at liberty to stake his claim in view of the said provision discussed hereinabove or any order grounds that he may chose while making his claim.

The writ petition stands disposed.
